A person should treat all creatures as he himself would be treated.

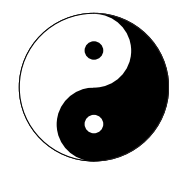

Do not do to others what you would not want them to do to you.

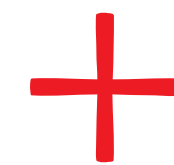
